

Waste Disposal while Traveling

When you travel, waste disposal is your responsibility

- Leftover solution in solution bags and effluent in drain bags and solution lines should be drained, then disposed of in accordance with local laws
- This typically means these products are thrown away with regular garbage
- Some areas are able to recycle materials; you should check recycling websites at your destination





At the end of your trip, you may have leftover PD supplies; you can either take them home with you or dispose of them <u>Baxter cannot accept returns of unused supplies</u>

- Unused disposable products like APD sets, caps, etc. should be disposed of in accordance with local laws, which usually means they are thrown away with regular garbage
- Unused solution bags should be drained first, then disposed of in accordance with local laws
- To drain, break the seal of the solution bag, uncap the connector, and place the bag in the sink, bathtub, or shower to allow it to drain
